*Right hand*—*yaw-meen'* **H3225**  
From **H3231**; the *right hand* or side  
(leg, eye) of a person or other object  
(as the *stronger* and more dexterous);

Even there Your hand will lead me,

And Your *right hand* will lay hold of me.

That Your **beloved** may be delivered,

*Strengthen*—'âmats aw-mats' (H553)

A primitive root; to *be alert*, physically  
(on foot) or mentally (in courage): - confirm,  
be courageous (of good courage,  
steadfastly minded, strong, stronger),  
establish, fortify, harden, increase, prevail,  
strengthen (self), make strong (obstinate, speed).

Yes, I will help you,

*Help*—'âzar aw-zar' (H5826)

A primitive root; to *surround*, that is,  
*protect* or *aid*: - help, succour.



I will uphold

*Uphold*—tâmak taw-mak' (H8551)

A primitive root; to sustain; by implication  
to *obtain*, *keep fast*; figuratively to *help*, *follow close*:  
- (take, up-) hold (up), maintain, retain, stay (up).

you with My righteous right hand.'

*Right hand*—*yaw-meen'* **H3225**

From **H3231**; the *right hand* or side (leg, eye) of a person  
or other object (as the *stronger* and more dexterous);

For I the Lord thy God will *hold*  
thy right hand saying unto thee  
fear not,

I will help thee.

Isaiah 41:13

(God is holding us with His right hand,  
by our right hand, what could be stronger?)



*Hold* **châzaq** khaw-zak' -**H2388**

A primitive root; to *fasten* upon; hence to *seize*,  
*be strong* (figuratively *courageous*, causatively  
*strengthen*, *cure*, *help*, *repair*, *fortify*), *obstinate*;
