He gives power to the weak, and to those who have no might He increases strength Even the youths shall faint and be weary, and the young men shall utterly fall, but those who wait on the Lord shall renew their strength they shall mount up with wings like eagles, they shall run and not be weary, they shall walk and not faint. Help-'azar aw-zar' (H5826) A primitive root; to surround, that is, protect or aid: - help, succour.

Fear not, for I AM with you; be not dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you, Yes, I will help you, I will uphold you with My righteous right hand.' Isaiah 41:10

Strengthen-'âmats aw-mats' (H553) A primitive root; to be alert, physically (on foot) or mentally (in courage): - confirm, be courageous (of good courage, steadfastly minded, strong, stronger), establish, fortify, harden, increase, prevail, strengthen (self), make strong (obstinate, speed)
